Govt unveils energy bill relief scheme for businesses

Clean Maritime Demonstration Competition — £60m R&D funding available for technology UK SHORE have announced the launch of the third round of the Clean Maritime Demonstration

Competition (CMDC), which will allocate £60m of match R&D funding for technology and system demonstrations in clean maritime solutions between April 2023 and March 2025. The application window will close at 11:00 on 9 November 2022. The CMDC programme is a multi-year R&D funding initiative and Maritime UK is working with the Department for Transport, Innovate UK and Innovate UK KTN to deliver a number of regionally focussed CMDC Industry Update Events.
